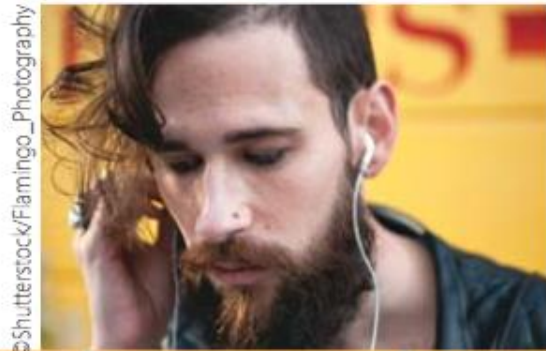

Ted: No! But that's my girlfriend!

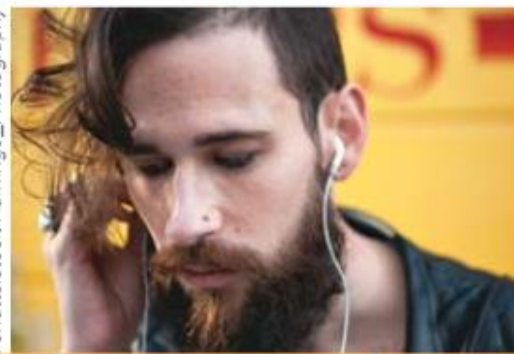
Rachel: Ha ha!
