1. POLYSEMY

- **Polysemy** – is the ability of a word to possess several meanings or lexico-semantic variants (LSV), e.g. *bright* means “shining” and “intelligent”.

In every language, there are words with multiple meanings. They are written and pronounced the same, but depending on the context they indicate different ideas. This is called **polysemy**.

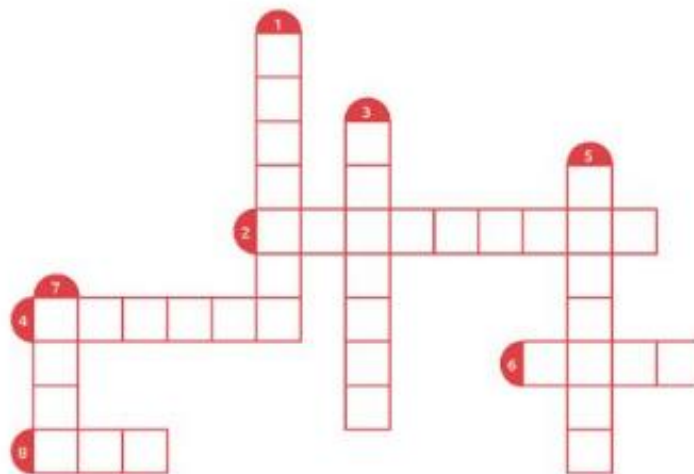
